Definitions

These terms will have these meanings in this policy:

- a. "Complainant" - The party appealing a decision,
- b. "Days" – Days irrespective of weekends or holidays,
- c. "Respondent" – The body whose decision is being appealed,
- d. "Member" – All categories of membership defined in the Ontario Skeet Shooting Association's Bylaws, as well as all individuals engaged in activities with the Ontario Skeet Shooting Association, including but not limited to, directors, officers, committee members, coaches, athletes, officials, referees, volunteers, and administrators,
- e. "OSSA" – Ontario Skeet Shooting Association

Purpose

Both the complainant and the respondent shall have the right to appeal the decisions and recommendations of the case review panel. A notice of intention to appeal, along with grounds for the appeal, must be provided to the chairperson of the case review panel within fourteen (14) days of the complainant or respondent receiving the panel's report.

Permissible grounds for an appeal are:

- a. The panel did not follow procedures laid out in this policy or has otherwise failed to act in a fair and impartial manner;
- b. Members of the panel were influenced by bias;
- c. The panel reached a decision which was patently unfair or unreasonable.

In the event that a notice of appeal is filed with the Secretary of the OSSA, the Secretary shall immediately contact the OSSA President and the Vice-President who together shall appoint a minimum of three (3) members to constitute the appeal body. Up to two (2) members of the panel may also be appointed from outside the OSSA. This appeal body shall consist of at least one (1) woman and at least one (1) man. These individuals must have no significant personal or professional involvement with either the complainant or respondent and no prior involvement in the dispute between them.

The appeal body shall base its decision solely on a review of the documentation surrounding the complaint, including the complainant's and respondent's statement and the case review panel and the notice of appeal.

Within 10 (ten) days of its appointment, the appeal body shall present a report of its findings to the OSSA President and the Vice-President. The appeal body shall have the authority to uphold the decision of the panel, to reverse the decision of the panel, and/or modify any of the panels' recommendations for disciplinary action or remedial measures.
