Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, Assumption of Risks, Photo Release, and Indemnity I hereby agree, in return for becoming a member of the Ontario Skeet Shooting Association (OSSA):

- To Release the OSSA, event organization bodies, sanctioning bodies, and OSSA sponsors and their respective directors, officer, employees, agents, volunteers, contractors, representatives, successors or assigns, (collectively "Releases") from any liability for any loss, damage, injury, or expense (collectively "Loss") that I may suffer as a result of any participation in and transportation to or from any OSSA program, due to any cause, including negligence or breach of contract.
- To waive any claim that I have or may have against any or all of the Releases regarding any matter, including without limitation, any claim arising out of any OSSA programs.
- To indemnify the Releases from any and all claims, actions, or Loss resulting in any way from my participation or participation of the child named below in any OSSA program.
- This document shall bind my heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, and representatives, and will have effect throughout my membership in the OSSA and, to the extent reasonably necessary to give it effect, thereafter.

OSSA MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Adult Membership - Fee, \$25.00

Subject to the Ontario Skeet Shooting Associations' Rules and Regulations, a regular adult membership allows one to coach or manage OSSA affiliated member Club competitive team(s) and in OSSA affiliated member Club-house leagues. It also entitles one to participate in the Ontario Provincial Skeet Championships. In addition, regular members receive the right to vote at the Annual Meeting(s) of Members. A regular adult membership can include the following role: club executive, coach/team manager, elite development program coach, etc. Other member benefits include membership acknowledgement and receipt of OSSA's newsletter "Station 9" – publication of event schedules, up-to-date news, and other information.

Associate Membership - Fee, \$5.00

Subject to the Ontario Skeet Shooting Associations' Rules and Regulations, an associate membership is a limited membership which entitles the member to receive the OSSA's newsletter "Station 9". Further, an associate member is limited to being allowed to observe the events, but not to participate in the events.

Complimentary Limited Membership (CLM) - Fee, \$1.00

This membership fee is a one-time fee for new members only who have never shot registered targets with another clay target organization. Membership benefits include member acknowledgment, eligibility to compete in registered skeet tournaments, and receipt of the OSSA's newsletter "Station 9" – publication of event schedules, up-to-date news, and other information. Note: The membership **does not** include voting privileges at the Annual Meeting(s) of Members.

Honorary / Life Membership - Fee, Discretionary

This type of membership is bestowed on individuals in recognition of their support of and to furthering the Associations' purposes. Life members are voting members. The annual fee is paid to the Association at the discretion of the Honorary / Life Member. Life members will have only one (1) vote at any and all meetings. The Board of Directors is empowered to grant honorary life memberships from time to time, at their discretion.

Sub-Junior / Junior Membership - Fee, \$1.00

Subject to the Ontario Skeet Shooting Associations' Rules and Regulations, a sub-junior or junior membership entitles one to participate in any OSSA sanctioned registered tournament in Ontario. It also entitles one to participate in the Ontario Provincial Junior Championships. Other membership benefits include membership acknowledgement and receipt of the OSSA's newsletter "Station 9" – publication of event schedules, up-to-date news, and other information. Note: Unless an adult membership fee of \$25.00 is paid, a sub-junior or junior member does not have the right to vote at the Annual Meeting(s) of Members.

Athletes' Code of Conduct Guidelines

- Always model mature behaviour consistent with that of the OSSA's Code of Conduct
- Fair Play is an athlete's first priority
- Participate for the love and enjoyment of the game
- Respect the efforts and accomplishments of your teammates and your opponents
- Respect Officials, Coaches, Spectators, and Event Organizers
- Respect the facility you visit or in which you play
- Respect the Rules of the Game

Official's Code of Conduct Guidelines

- Accept an assignment to officiate at a competition only if one intends to honour that commitment. If, for any reason,
 one is unable to attend, notify the person in charge of officials as soon as possible of inability to meet the commitment
- Be fair and objective
- Avoid situations in which a conflict of interest may arise
- Be impartial, unobtrusive, and inconspicuous as possible
- Conduct all events according to the rules of the sport
- Make independent judgements

Coaches Code of Conduct Guidelines

- Always model mature behaviours consistent with that of the OSSA's Code of Conduct
- Be a leader, a positive influence, and a role model
- Reward effort, Fair Play, and commitment
- Recognize and respect the difference in your athletes
- Demonstrate respect for all individuals involved in the game
- Always consider the physical and emotional well-being of athletes
- Always attempt to contribute to the betterment of the game
