The Knotty pine 200 started in 2001.

After 22 years there have been 42 hundred straights shot by 23 different shooters.

Reg Hooper holds the record with 6 including one 2x2

the only one to accomplish this twice, John held the long run record with 354 straight from 2006 until 2014.

and has held the long run record since 2014 with an incredible 376 straight.

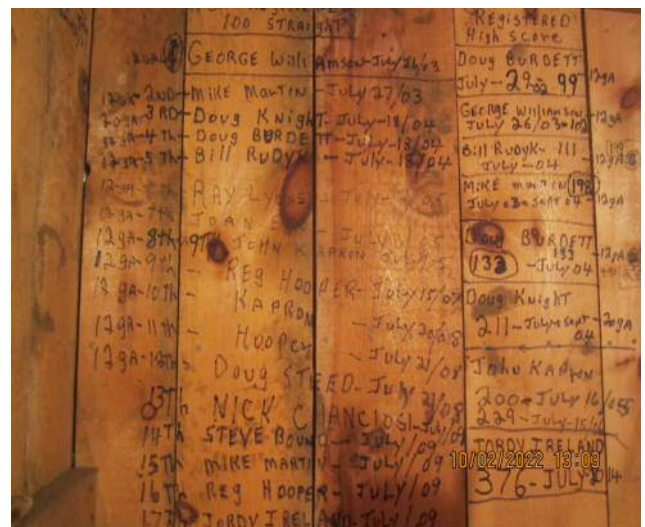

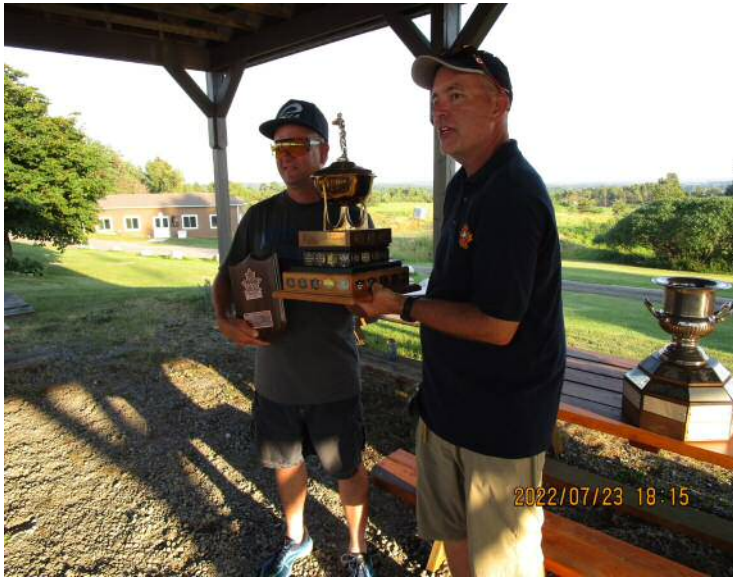
