The OSSA board at the last meeting has tentatively made plans to conduct an Ontario Provincial Junior Championship. This shoot will be only for junior shooters.

Juniors who wish to participate in this event cannot have reached their 23<sup>rd</sup> birthday by the date of this shoot (This is the same cut off for juniors in the summer games)

We are planning this event as a 100 Bird shoot Saturday July 8th, 2017 This is a Registered /Non registered shoot and you are given the option to register if you wish. The event will start approx 1:00pm with a practice field available in the morning for those who wish to shoot a practice round or two. This shoot is open to all junior shooters with no pre selection process as in the Summer Games. We are planning to conduct this junior championship at the Knotty Pine Club in Kirkfield which should be central to most shooters.

Gold, Silver, Bronze medals will be presented to the top three shooters. This will be your event and conducted with NSSA rules governing registered events. British Columbia appears to be gaining traction and activity. Their early shoots have been well attended and they are gaining new members. This is due to a lot of encouragement and promotion by a core of enthusiastic shooters that seem to be driving this.

The New Zealand and Australian seasons are in full swing, and from what I have been able to gather from Facebook posts, things are moving quite briskly there as well, with decent attendance at their events.

We are expecting to have good attendance at our satellite Zone 8 shoot in August. Britain participated for the first time in 2016 and the results were favourable and greater participation is expected this year. There should be a high number of participating clubs in Canada as well.

Memberships for OSSA have increased for 2017 to 25 Dollars per year. The sport funding organization who release grants to the sport s required that The Ontario Council of Shooters be the Agency which forms a contract with Ministry of sport. The Ontario Council of Shooters was granted full recognition with a couple of conditions and is eligible to apply for Ontario Amateur Sport Fund application.

This contract was finally approved by the Ministry in March 2017 and funds released to the Council. you would see the result of this in travel funds)

Membership Fee of \$10 per member goes to OCS and \$4 goes to Shooting Federation of Canada (SFC)

Thus OSSA dues increased by \$10 to \$25 per year
