 - b. Discussions regarding the costs associated with medals, etc.

- c. Advance Registration will include a \$50 deposit. S. Malcolm contact person for advance registration and pre-squadding.

 - a. 2024 edition scheduled for 03 August 2024 at Knotty Pine. Additional details to follow.
8. OSSA Policy Updates – Policy updates to be completed and uploaded to the website ASAP (note – majority completed and posted).
9. Discussions regarding the OASF Grant and OSSA's commitments to receiving the funding.
10. Creation of "Advertising" – pamphlet and directory.
 - a. Directory is on the OSSA's website – Clubs that have renewed membership with the OSSA.
 - b. Pamphlet to be created for distribution to Member Clubs, Sporting Goods Stores, etc.
11. Chief Referee D. Steed advised scheduling for 2024 Clinics has begun. Contact him directly to arrange for a Clinic / attend a Clinic.

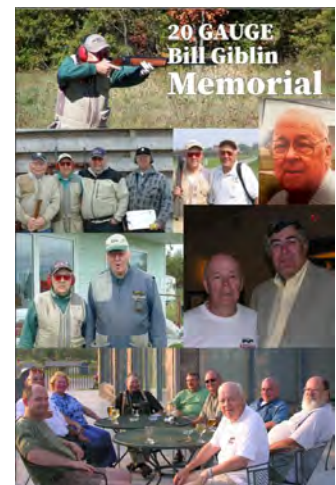

Of course to the Juniors that came out for some friendly competition, and to the people in their life that allow them to shoot.

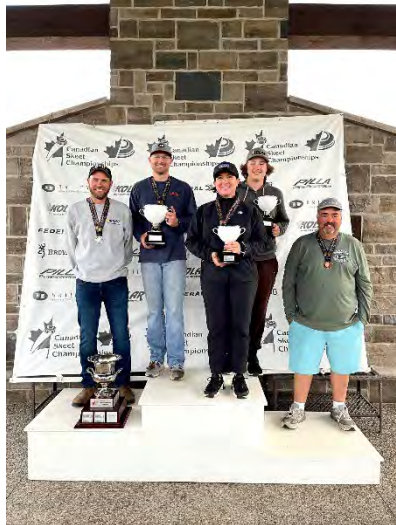

2024 Provincials

The 2024 edition of the Ontario Open & Closed Skeet Championships will be here before we know it. This year’s Championship will be held at the Oshawa Clay & Target Club.

Advance Registration has been open for some time now. Available spots are becoming scarce. If you have not already registered, please do so ASAP by emailing Steve at steve.malcolm23@gmail.com

Note: A \$50 deposit is required with each advance registration.

Oshawa Clay & Target Club is currently renovating their Club House. There will be johnny-on-the-spots available for attendees.

NOTE: There is *no water available* at the Club to fill your camper. You will need to fill your camper prior to arriving at the Oshawa Clay & Target Club.

There will be a BBQ lunch available during the Provincial Championships.

The Club is using a “construction-type” trailer for their Club House. As such, the OSSA will have limited space within the trailer for registration / general administration associated with the Provincials.

There is a specific egress pattern within the trailer. All access is through the REAR DOOR (signs posted). All exit is through the FRONT DOOR (signs posted).

The OSSA BOD kindly asks for your patience during the registration process as only one (1) or two (2) Provincial Championship participants may be in the trailer at a time.

The individual medals will be placed on tables underneath pop-up shelters (location(s) TBD). Again, the OSSA BOD kindly asks for your patience during the distribution process for the medals. As with past practice, there

will be sheets to sign when you pick up your medal(s).

The OSSA BOD is looking at different options to expedite processes before, during, and after the weekend for everyone’s benefit.

While the physical structures may look different than in past years, the OSSA BOD is confident that the 77th Ontario Open & Closed Provincial Skeet Championships will be an excellent tournament.
